Clubhouse Rules

Guidelines for a Greenwood Acres Community

Introduction

The clubhouse is a valuable asset for our community, serving as a space for events, gatherings, and daily activities. To ensure that all members can enjoy and benefit from the clubhouse, it is essential to adhere to the following set of rules and guidelines.

General Conduct

Usage and Reservations

- Reservations: To use the clubhouse for private events, reservations must be made in advance through the designated booking system. (Web Site) Ensure all details are accurately provided.
- Event Size: Adhere to the maximum capacity limits for events to ensure safety and comfort for all attendees.

Facilities and Equipment

• Care of Equipment: Use all clubhouse facilities and equipment as intended. Report any malfunctions or damages to the management promptly.

- Personal Belongings: Do not leave personal belongings in the clubhouse. The HOA
 is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Decorations: If decorating for an event, ensure that all decorations are removed after use. Do not use nails or other materials that could damage the walls or furniture.

Food and Beverage

- Consumption Rules: Food and beverages are allowed in designated areas only.
 Ensure that no food or drink is left unattended and that all waste is disposed of properly.
- Alcohol Policy: Alcohol consumption is permitted during events. Ensure that all local laws and regulations regarding alcohol consumption are followed.
- Smoking: Smoking is strictly prohibited inside the clubhouse. Designated smoking areas are available outside the premises.

Safety and Security

- Emergency Procedures: Familiarize yourself with the emergency exits and procedures. In case of an emergency, follow the clubhouse's evacuation plan.
- Security Measures: Do not tamper with security systems or devices. Report any suspicious activities to the HOA Board member immediately.
